Sec. 2-13.2. Jury Trial. In any proceeding on a petition (1) seeking a finding that a minor is neglected, abused, or dependent, or (2) seeking a finding that a parent is unfit and that it is in the best interest of the child to terminate parental rights, under this Act or the Adoption Act, a parent may demand trial by jury.

13 Section 10. The Adoption Act is amended by adding 14 Section 13.2 as follows:

15 (705 ILCS 405/13.2 new)

Sec. 13.2. Jury Trial. In any proceeding on a petition seeking a finding that a parent is unfit and that it is in the best interest of the child to terminate parental rights, under this Act or the Juvenile Court Act of 1987, a parent may demand trial by jury.
