- 7 Sec. 8.5. Replacement of lost money orders. A community
- 8 <u>currency exchange or ambulatory currency exchange shall issue</u>
- 9 <u>a replacement money order for a non-negotiated money order</u>
- 10 that has been lost, destroyed, or defaced within 3 business
- 11 <u>days after being furnished with:</u>
- 12 <u>(1) proof of identification of the claimant (a</u>
- 13 government issued identification card shall constitute
- 14 <u>sufficient proof of identification);</u>
- 15 (2) proof of ownership (a receipt issued by the
- 16 <u>currency exchange or an entry in the currency exchange's</u>
- 17 <u>records along with proof of identification shall</u>
- constitute sufficient proof of ownership);
- 19 (3) proof of loss or destruction or, in the case of
- a defaced money order, the money order;
- 21 (4) adequate security to indemnify the issuing
- 22 <u>currency exchange against any loss it may suffer on</u>
- 23 <u>account of the replacement; and</u>
- 24 (5) payment of the cost of preparation of the
