The additional \$2 fee for certified copies of death certificates 8 9 and fetal death certificates must be deposited into the Death 10 Certificate Surcharge Fund, a special fund created in the State treasury. Beginning 30 days after the effective date 11 of this amendatory Act of the 92nd General Assembly and until 12 1, 2003, moneys in the Fund, subject to 13 January 14 appropriation, may be used by the Department for the purpose of implementing an electronic reporting system for death 15 registrations as provided in Section 18.5 of this Act. 16 17 Before the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 92nd General Assembly and on and after January 1, 2003, moneys in 18 the Fund, subject to appropriations, may be used as follows: 19 (i) 25% by the Illinois Law Enforcement Training Standards 20 Board for the purpose of training coroners, deputy coroners, 21 22 forensic pathologists, and police officers for homicide

1 investigations, (ii) 25% for grants by the Department of 2 Public Health by-the-Illinois-Necropsy-Board for distribution 3 to all local county coroners and medical examiners or officials charged with the duties set forth under Division 4 5 3-3 of the Counties Code, who have a different title, for 6 equipment and lab facilities for-local-county-coroners, (iii) 7 25% by the Department of Public Health for the purpose of setting up a statewide database of death certificates and 8 9 implementing an electronic reporting system for death 10 registrations pursuant to Section 18.5, and (iv) 25% for a grant by the Department of Public Health to local registrars. 11 (Source: P.A. 91-382, eff. 7-30-99; 92-16, eff. 6-28-01; 12 92-141, eff. 7-24-01.)". 13
