AN ACT concerning grain.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Grain Code is amended by changing Section
1-5 as follows:

6 (240 ILCS 40/1-5)

Sec. 1-5. Purpose. The Illinois grain industry 7 8 comprises a significant and vital part of the State's economy. The grain industry can function to its fullest 9 competitive and profitable potential, thus contributing to 10 the economic health of this State, when it operates under a 11 coordinated and integrated structure. The purpose of this 12 13 Code is to provide a single system of governmental regulation of the Illinois grain industry. It is also the purpose of 14 15 this Code to promote the State's welfare by improving the 16 economic stability of agriculture through the existence of the Illinois Grain Insurance Fund in--order to protect 17 producers in the event of the failure of a licensed grain 18 dealer or licensed warehouseman and to ensure the existence 19 20 of an adequate resource so that persons holding valid claims may be compensated for losses occasioned by the failure of a 21 22 licensed grain dealer or licensed warehouseman.
