AN ACT concerning the courts.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Judicial Vacancies Act is amended by 5 changing Section 1.1 as follows:

7 Sec. 1.1. Definitions. As used in this Act, the term "resident circuit judge" or "resident judge" refers to a 8 circuit judge who, immediately prior to July 1, 1971, was an 9 associate judge and who became a circuit judge on July 1, 10 1971 by reason of paragraph (a) of Section 4 of the 11 Transition Schedule of the Constitution of 1970 or a circuit 12 judge who was appointed after June 30, 1971 by the Supreme 13 Court to fill the vacancy existing prior to July 1, 1971 in 14 the office of a former associate judge and whose office was, 15 16 prior to July 1, 1971, filled by election from a single county or, in the case of Cook County, from one of the 2 17 18 units of the county, and not from the circuit at large.
