- 4 Section 5. The Firearm Owners Identification Card Act is
- 5 amended by adding Section 3.5 as follows:
- 6 (430 ILCS 65/3.5 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 3.5. Private transfers of firearms by persons</u>
- 8 attending gun shows.
- 9 (a) Any person who is not a federally licensed firearm
- dealer who desires to transfer a firearm while that person is
- on the grounds of a gun show must do so only through a
- 12 <u>federally licensed firearm dealer. The dealer must follow</u>
- 13 the procedure set forth in Section 3.1 of this Act as if the
- dealer were the seller of the firearm.
- 15 (b) In this Act:
- 16 <u>"Gun show" means the entire premises provided for an</u>
- 17 <u>event or function, including but not limited to parking areas</u>
