- 7 Sec. 3.2. <u>Notice.</u> No officer shall be subjected to
- 8 interrogation without first being informed in writing of the

- 11 <u>before the day of the interrogation, unless this requirement</u>
- 12 <u>is waived by the officer being interrogated</u>. If an
- 13 administrative proceeding is instituted, the officer shall be
- 14 informed beforehand of the names of all complainants. The
- information shall be sufficient as to reasonably apprise the
- officer of the nature of the investigation.
