AN ACT in relation to criminal law.

- Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:
- Section 5. The Unified Code of Corrections is amended by
 adding Section 5-9-1.12 as follows:
- 6 (730 ILCS 5/5-9-1.12 new)

Sec. 5-9-1.12. Applications for transfer to other 7 8 states. A person subject to conditions of probation, parole, 9 or mandatory supervised release who seeks to transfer to another state subject to the Interstate Compact for Adult 10 Offender Supervision must make provisions for the payment of 11 any restitution awarded by the circuit court and pay a fee of 12 \$125 to the proper administrative or judicial authorities 13 before being granted the transfer, or otherwise arrange for 14 payment. The fee payment from persons subject to a sentence 15 16 of probation shall be deposited into the general fund of the county in which the circuit has jurisdiction. The fee 17 payment from persons subject to parole or mandatory 18 supervised release shall be deposited into the General 19 Revenue Fund. The proceeds of this fee shall be used to 20 defray the costs of the Department of Corrections or county 21 sheriff departments, respectively, who will be required to 22 retrieve offenders that violate the terms of their transfers 23 to other states. Upon return to the State of Illinois, these 24 persons shall also be subject to reimbursing either the State 25 of Illinois or the county for the actual costs of returning 26 27 them to Illinois.
