- 4 Section 5. The School Code is amended by adding Section
- 5 2-3.131 as follows:

- 7 Sec. 2-3.131. K-3 class size reduction grant program. A
- 8 class size reduction grant program is hereby created. The
- program shall be implemented and administered by the State 9
- Board of Education, which shall award grants to school 10
- districts that meet the criteria established by this Section 11
- 12 for the award of those grants. The State Board of Education

- Grants shall be awarded pursuant to application. The 15
- form and manner of applications and the criteria for the 16
