- 8 Sec. 30-170. Mosquito abatement district.
- 9 (a) The electors may authorize the township board to
- 10 contract for the furnishing of mosquito abatement services in
- 11 the unincorporated area of the township.
- 12 <u>(a-5) Notwithstanding any other provision of this Code</u>,
- 13 <u>as provided in Section 0.03 of the Mosquito Abatement</u>
- 14 <u>District Act, on July 1, 2004 the North Shore Mosquito</u>
- 15 <u>Abatement District and the South Cook County Mosquito</u>
