(C) any firearm (other than a machine gun), which, although designed as a weapon, the Department of State Police finds by reason of the date of its manufacture, value, design, and other characteristics is primarily a collector's item and is not likely to be used as a weapon.

(c) Except as provided in subsection (e), 90 days after the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 93rd General Assembly, it is unlawful for any person within this State, to knowingly manufacture, deliver, or possess or cause to be manufactured, delivered, or possessed, a semiautomatic assault weapon, a large capacity ammunition feeding device, or an assault weapon attachment.

(d) Any person who knowingly possesses a semiautomatic assault weapon, large capacity ammunition feeding device, or
