2 "Violent crime" means any felony in which force or threat of force was used against the victim, or any offense 3 4 involving sexual exploitation, sexual conduct or sexual penetration, domestic battery, violation of an order of 5 6 protection, stalking, or any misdemeanor which results in 7 death or great bodily harm to the victim or any violation of Section 9-3 of the Criminal Code of 1961, or Section 11-501 8 9 of the Illinois Vehicle Code, or a similar provision of a local ordinance, if the violation resulted in personal injury 10 11 or death, and includes any action committed by a juvenile that would be a violent crime if committed by an adult. For 12 the purposes of this Act, "personal injury" shall include 13 include severely bleeding wounds, 14 shall distorted 15 extremities, injuries that require immediate 16 attention, and injuries that require the injured party to be carried from the scene; 17

18 Section 20. Immigrant crime victim reporting program. The Department of Human Services shall establish a program 19 2.0 for the investigation of crimes committed against victims in this State who are undocumented residents of the United 21 22 States. The Department shall have the duty and authority to investigate all criminal complaints made by victims who are 23 24 undocumented residents of the United States and shall not release to any other State or federal agency any identifying 25 information about the victim or his or her family unless the 26 victim signs a written document allowing this release of 27 information. Even if the victim does not sign this release, 28 29 the Department has the obligation to investigate the victim's 30 complaint.

31 Section 25. Petition by Governor. In cases where the 32 legal immigration status is necessary for the investigation

- 1 or prosecution of any violent crime or felony offense, the
- 2 Governor of this State shall petition the appropriate federal
- 3 agency to obtain legal immigration status for the victim or
- 4 any witness necessary to the investigation or prosecution.
- 5 Section 99. This Act takes effect upon becoming law.
