(a) At any time, in the opinion of the Warden, the lives

- 3 <u>Developmental Disabilities Code</u>. If the physician,
- 4 psychiatrist, or qualified examiner determines that the
- 5 <u>prisoner is in need of mental health or developmental</u>
- 6 <u>disability services</u>, the Warden shall transfer the prisoner
- 7 <u>to such other facility for the appropriate treatment.</u>
