AN ACT in relation to criminal law.

- Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:
- Section 5. The Criminal Code of 1961 is amended by adding
 Section 20-3 as follows:
- б (720 ILCS 5/20-3 new) Sec. 20-3. Causing a fire or explosion by controlled 7 substance manufacturing. 8 (a) A person commits the offense of causing a fire or 9 explosion by controlled substance manufacturing when during 10 the unlawful manufacture of a controlled substance, he or she 11 12 causes a fire or explosion to occur by virtue of any of the 13 following: 14 (1) Knowingly manufacturing or attempting to 15 manufacture a controlled substance; or 16 (2) Knowingly attempting to extract, create or synthesize a substance for the use in the manufacture of 17 18 a controlled substance; or 19 (3) Knowingly storing precursors, essential 20 ingredients or clandestine laboratory apparatus in such a manner as to cause a fire or explosion. 21 22 (b) Sentence. Causing a fire or explosion by controlled
- 23 <u>substance manufacturing is a Class 2 felony.</u>
- Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect uponbecoming law.
