- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Illinois Controlled Substances Act is
- 5 amended by adding Section 405.3 as follows:
- 6 (720 ILCS 570/405.3 new)
- 7 Sec. 405.3. Criminal synthetic drug manufacturing
- 8 conspiracy.
- 9 (a) A person commits criminal synthetic drug
- 10 <u>manufacturing conspiracy when, with the intent that a</u>
- 11 <u>controlled substance be manufactured or produced in violation</u>
- of any provision of Section 401, 402, 406.1, or 407, he or
- 13 she aids in the manufacture or production of a synthetic
- 14 <u>controlled substance. No person may be convicted of criminal</u>
- 15 synthetic drug manufacturing conspiracy unless an act in
- 16 <u>furtherance to aid in the manufacture or production of a</u>
- 17 <u>synthetic controlled substance is alleged and proved to have</u>
- been committed by the person or a co-conspirator.
- 19 <u>(b) Aiding in the manufacture of a synthetic controlled</u>
- 20 <u>substance</u> may be accomplished by: (1) providing
- 21 <u>methamphetamine</u> <u>manufacturing</u> <u>chemicals</u>, <u>precursors</u>,
- 22 <u>essential ingredients, or apparatus required to produce the</u>

- 4 <u>watercraft, any structure capable of holding a clandestine</u>

- 6 (e) It is not a defense to conspiracy that the person or
- 7 persons with whom the accused is alleged to have conspired:
- 8 (1) have not been prosecuted or convicted; or
- 9 (2) have been convicted of a different offense; or
- 10 (3) are not amenable to justice; or
- 11 (4) have been acquitted; or
- 12 (5) lacked the capacity to commit the offense.
- 13 (f) Sentence. A person convicted of criminal synthetic
- 14 <u>drug manufacturing conspiracy may be fined or imprisoned or</u>
- both, but any fines or term of imprisonment imposed may not
- 16 <u>be less than the minimum nor more than the maximum provided</u>
- for the offense that is the object of the conspiracy.
