- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Counties Code is amended by adding
- 5 Section 5-1062.2 as follows:
- 6 (55 ILCS 5/5-1062.2 new)
- 7 Sec. 5-1062.2. Sediment and erosion control program. In
- 8 <u>accordance with the EPA Phase II requirements for development</u>
- 9 of sediment and erosion control regulations and
- 10 post-construction run-off control, the county board of each
- 11 county may adopt, implement, and enforce a sediment and
- 12 <u>erosion control program to mitigate the effects of increased</u>
- 13 <u>stormwater run-off due to new development or redevelopment</u>
- 14 within the county. Additionally, the county may adopt a
- 15 <u>schedule of fees as necessary to mitigate the effects of</u>
- increased stormwater runoff. The fees may not exceed the cost
- 17 of satisfying the on-site stormwater retention or detention
- 18 <u>requirements of the adopted stormwater management plan. The</u>
- 19 <u>fees shall be held in a separate fund and may be used only to</u>
- 20 <u>adopt, implement, and enforce the sediment and erosion</u>
