- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Electricity Excise Tax Law is amended by
- 5 adding Section 2-5.5 as follows:
- 6 (35 ILCS 640/2-5.5 new)
- 7 Sec. 2-5.5. Exemption for religious purposes,
- 8 <u>orphanages</u>, or school and religious purposes. Beginning with
- 9 <u>bills</u> for electricity or electric service issued on or after
- January 1, 2004, the tax imposed under this Act does not
- 11 apply to property used exclusively for religious purposes,
- 12 <u>used exclusively for school and religious purposes</u>, or <u>used</u>
- 13 <u>exclusively</u> for <u>orphanages</u> and not leased or otherwise used
- 14 <u>with a view to profit. This exemption includes all such</u>
- 15 property owned by churches or religious institutions or
- 16 <u>denominations and used in conjunction therewith as housing</u>
- 17 <u>facilities provided for ministers (including bishops,</u>
- 18 <u>district superintendents, and similar church officials whose</u>
- 19 <u>ministerial duties are not limited to a single congregation)</u>,
- 20 <u>their spouses, children, and domestic workers, performing the</u>

duties of their vocation as ministers at such churches or

religious institutions or for such religious denominations,

- 23 and including the convents and monasteries where persons
- 24 <u>engaged in religious activities reside</u>. A <u>parsonage</u>,
- 25 <u>convent</u>, <u>monastery</u>, <u>or other housing facility shall be</u>

- 28 <u>denomination requires that the above listed persons who</u>
