- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The General Not For Profit Corporation Act of
- 5 1986 is amended by adding Section 102.13 as follows:
- 6 (805 ILCS 105/102.13 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 102.13. Criminal history check; fingerprints.</u>
- 8 (a) For the purpose of this Section, "Department" means
- 9 <u>the Department of State Police.</u>
- 10 (b) If the articles of incorporation are for the
- 11 incorporation of a corporation having a purpose of working
- 12 with or for the benefit of youths, there shall be annexed to
- 13 the articles of incorporation 2 sets of fingerprints for each
- 14 <u>director of that corporation, for the purpose of determining</u>
- the criminal history of that director, in the form and manner
- that shall be specified by the Department of State Police,
- but in any event, no less than 2 digit imprints.
- 18 (c) Every set of fingerprints annexed to articles of
- 19 <u>incorporation pursuant to this Section shall be promptly</u>
- 20 <u>submitted to the Department.</u>
- 21 (d) The first set of fingerprints received by the
- 22 <u>Department shall be used to identify the individual and to</u>
- 23 <u>conduct a criminal history record search of the Department's</u>
- 24 <u>State files to determine whether or not that individual has</u>
- been convicted of a Class 4 felony in this State.
- 26 (e) The Department shall forward the second set of that
- 27 <u>individual's fingerprints to the Federal Bureau of</u>
- 28 <u>Investigation for the purpose of a nationwide criminal</u>
- 29 <u>history record check to determine whether that individual has</u>
- 30 <u>been convicted of a criminal offense in any state or federal</u>
- 31 jurisdiction that, if the individual had been convicted in

- 1 <u>Illinois, would have constituted a Class 4 felony in this</u>
- 2 State.
- 3 (f) The Department shall promptly transmit the reports
- 4 of the State and nationwide criminal records searches to the
- 5 <u>Secretary of State.</u>
- 6 (q) Each director of a corporation described in
- 7 <u>subsection (b) shall sign a release authorizing the Secretary</u>
- 8 of State to submit that director's fingerprints to the
- 9 Department and to receive the results of the criminal history
- 10 record searches supplied by the Department and the Federal
- 11 Bureau of Investigation.
- (h) Each director shall, in advance, make payment to the
- 13 Department of any fee authorized by law that is reasonably
- 14 related to the cost of conducting the searches required by
- 15 this Section.
- 16 <u>(i) The Secretary of State and the Director of State</u>
- 17 Police are authorized to adopt all rules necessary or
- 18 <u>convenient to implement the provisions of this Section.</u>
