- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Department of Veterans Affairs Act is
- 5 amended by changing Section 2.07 as follows:
- 6 (20 ILCS 2805/2.07) (from Ch. 126 1/2, par. 67.07)
- 7 Sec. 2.07. The Department shall employ and maintain
- 8 sufficient and qualified staff at the veterans' homes to
- 9 fulfill the requirements of this Act. The Department shall
- 10 report to the General Assembly, by January 1 and July 1 of
- 11 each year, the number of staff employed in providing direct
- 12 patient care at their veterans' homes, the compliance or
- 13 noncompliance with staffing standards established by the
- 14 United States Department of Veterans Affairs for such care,
- and in the event of noncompliance with such standards, the
- 16 number of staff required for compliance.
- 17 <u>All contracts between the State and outside contractors</u>
- 18 to provide workers to staff and service the Anna Veterans
- 19 <u>Home shall be canceled in accordance with the terms of those</u>
- 20 <u>contracts. Upon cancellation, each worker or staff member</u>
- 21 <u>shall be offered certified employment status under the</u>
- 22 <u>Illinois Personnel Code with the State of Illinois. To the</u>
- 23 <u>extent it is reasonably practicable, the position offered to</u>
- 24 <u>each person shall be at the same facility and shall consist</u>
