- 4 Section 5. the Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by
- 5 adding Section 7-604.1 as follows:

- 7 <u>Sec. 7-604.1. Insurance indicator stickers.</u>
- 8 (a) The Secretary shall, by January 1, 2004, adopt rules
- 9 providing for issuance, and display on the rear registration
- 10 plate of every vehicle, of a sticker indicating that the
- 11 <u>vehicle</u> is covered by liability insurance for the current
- 12 year.
- (b) Beginning July 1, 2004, every company selling
- 14 <u>automobile liability insurance coverage in this State must</u>
- 15 provide every vehicle insured by the company with a sticker
- for display as provided in subsection (a).
- (c) Beginning July 1, 2004, the driver of any vehicle
- 18 <u>failing to display the required sticker is guilty of a petty</u>
- offense punishable by a fine of \$100.
- 20 (d) Beginning July 1, 2004, display of the required
- 21 <u>sticker on a vehicle not covered by liability insurance is a</u>
