- 11 contraindicated.
- 12 (b) A facility shall provide or arrange for
- 13 <u>administration of a pneumococcal vaccination to each resident</u>
- 14 who is age 65 and over, in accordance with the
- 15 <u>recommendations of the Advisory Committee on Immunization</u>
- 16 <u>Practices of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention,</u>
- 17 who has not received this immunization prior to or upon
- 18 <u>admission to the facility, unless the resident refuses the</u>

- 28 (a) A facility shall annually administer a vaccination
- 29 <u>against influenza to each resident, in accordance with the</u>
- 30 <u>recommendations of the Advisory Committee on Immunization</u>
- 31 <u>Practices of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention</u>
- 32 that are most recent to the time of vaccination, unless the

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1 vaccination is medically contraindicated or the resident has 2 refused the vaccine. Influenza vaccinations for all residents age 65 and over shall be completed by November 30 of each 3 4 year or as soon as practicable if vaccine supplies are not available before November 1. Residents admitted after 5 November 30, during the flu season, and until February 1 6 shall, as medically appropriate, receive an influenza 7 8 vaccination prior to or upon admission or as soon as 9 practicable if vaccine supplies are not available at the time of the admission, unless the vaccine is medically 10 contraindicated or the resident has refused the vaccine. In 11 the event that the Advisory Committee on Immunization 12 13 Practices of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention determines that dates of administration other than those 14 15 stated in this Act are optimal to protect the health of 16 residents, the Department is authorized to develop rules to 17 mandate vaccinations at those times rather than the times stated in this Act. A facility shall document in the 18 resident's medical record that an annual vaccination against 19 influenza was administered, refused or medically 20 21 contraindicated. 22 (b) A facility shall provide or arrange for administration of a pneumococcal vaccination to each resident 23 who is age 65 and over, in accordance with the 24 recommendations of the Advisory Committee on Immunization 25 Practices of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, 26 who has not received this immunization prior to or upon 27 admission to the facility, unless the resident refuses the 28 offer for vaccination or the vaccination is medically 29 contraindicated. A facility shall document in each resident's 30 31 medical record that a vaccination against pneumococcal pneumonia was offered and administered, refused, or medically 32 Pneumonia--shots----Before--a--prospective 33 contraindicated. 34 resident's-admission-to-a-facility-the-facility-shall-advise
