AN ACT concerning education.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The School Code is amended by adding Section 22-26.5 as follows:

б (105 ILCS 5/22-26.5 new) Sec. 22-26.5. Four-Day School Week Task Force. The 7 Four-Day School Week Task Force is created to study the 8 effectiveness of a 4-day school week. The Task Force shall 9 consist of the following members: 10 (1) The State Superintendent of Education or his or 11 12 her designee. (2) Two members of the House of Representatives 13 appointed by the Speaker of the House. 14 (3) Two members of the House of Representatives 15 16 appointed by the Minority Leader of the House. (4) Two members of the Senate appointed by the 17 President of the Senate. 18 (5) Two members of the Senate appointed by the 19 20 Minority Leader of the Senate. (6) One teacher who is a member of the Illinois 21 Education Association, appointed by the State 22 Superintendent of Education. 23 (7) One teacher who is a member of the Illinois 24 Federation of Teachers, appointed by the State 25 Superintendent of Education. 26 (8) One member of the Illinois Statewide School 27 Management Alliance, appointed by the State 28 29 Superintendent of Education. The members of the Task Force shall serve without 30 compensation but shall be reimbursed for their reasonable and 31

1 necessary expenses from funds appropriated for that purpose. The Task Force shall meet initially at the call of the State 2 3 Superintendent of Education, shall select one member as 4 chairperson at its initial meeting, and shall thereafter meet 5 at the call of the chairperson. The Task Force shall receive б the assistance of staff of the State Board of Education. The 7 Task Force shall report its results on the study to the General Assembly before January 1, 2004. 8

9 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon10 becoming law.
