- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Illinois Insurance Code is amended by
- 5 changing Section 370b as follows:
- 6 (215 ILCS 5/370b) (from Ch. 73, par. 982b)
- 7 Sec. 370b. Reimbursement on equal basis.
- 8 Notwithstanding any provision of any individual or group
- 9 policy of accident and health insurance, or any provision of
- 10 a policy, contract, plan or agreement for hospital or medical
- 11 service or indemnity, wherever such policy, contract, plan or
- 12 agreement provides for reimbursement for any service provided
- 13 by persons licensed under the Medical Practice Act of 1987 or
- 14 <u>under</u> the Podiatric Medical Practice Act of 1987, the person
- 15 entitled to benefits or person performing services under such
- 16 policy, contract, plan or agreement is entitled to
- 17 reimbursement on an equal basis for such service, when the
- 18 service is performed by a person licensed under the Medical
- 19 Practice Act of 1987 or the Podiatric Medical Practice Act of
- 21 policy, contract, plan or agreement in effect prior to
