- 1 AN ACT concerning boards and commissions.
- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Military Code of Illinois is amended by
- 5 adding Section 25.6 as follows:
- 6 (20 ILCS 1805/25.6 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 25.6. Illinois Military Flags Commission.</u>
- 8 <u>(a) The Illinois Military Flags Commission is</u>
- 9 <u>established for the purpose of assisting the Adjutant General</u>
- 10 with his or her responsibilities under Section 25 of this
- 11 <u>Code</u>. The Commission shall advise the Adjutant General on
- 12 <u>how to best collect, preserve, and present or display to the</u>
- 13 public the colors, flags, guidons, and military trophies of
- 14 <u>war belonging to the State in order to disseminate</u>
- 15 <u>information relating to the history of the Illinois National</u>
- 16 Guard.
- 17 (b) The Commission consists of 15 members: the Adjutant
- 18 General, the State Historian, the Director of the Illinois
- 19 <u>State Museum, and the Director of the Historic Preservation</u>
- 20 Agency, all ex officio; 4 members of the General Assembly,
- 21 <u>one of whom shall be appointed by the President of the</u>
- 22 <u>Senate, one by the Minority Leader of the Senate, one by the</u>
- 23 <u>Speaker of the House of Representatives, and one by the</u>
- 24 <u>Minority Leader of the House of Representatives; and 7</u>
- 25 <u>residents of the State appointed by the Governor. When</u>
- 26 <u>appointing members to the Commission, the Governor must</u>
- 27 <u>endeavor to appoint persons in a manner to maintain as</u>
- 28 <u>regionally diverse a membership as possible. Persons</u>
- 29 <u>appointed to the Commission should provide it with experience</u>
- in areas such as, but not limited to, knowledge of military
- 31 <u>history</u>, particularly of the American Civil War, and the

- education of citizens. Any vacancy in the Commission shall 1
- be filled by an appointment in the same manner as the 2
- 3 original appointment. Members of the Commission shall serve
- without compensation, but shall be reimbursed for their 4
- reasonable expenses incurred in the performance of their 5
- 6 <u>duties.</u>
- 7 (c) This Section is repealed on January 1, 2006.
- 8 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 9 becoming law.
