- 4 Section 5. The Criminal Code of 1961 is amended by
- 5 adding Section 12-7.6 as follows:
- 6 (720 ILCS 5/12-7.6 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 12-7.6. Cross burning.</u>
- 8 (a) A person commits the offense of cross burning who,
- 9 with the intent to intimidate any other person or group of
- 10 persons, burns or causes to be burned a cross.
- 11 (b) Sentence. Cross burning is a Class A misdemeanor for
- 12 <u>a first offense and a Class 4 felony for a second or</u>
- 13 <u>subsequent offense.</u>
- (c) For the purposes of this Section, a person acts with
- 15 the "intent to intimidate" when he or she intentionally
- 16 places or attempts to place another person in fear of
- 17 physical injury or fear of damage to that other person's
- 18 property.
