SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

50 ILCS 105/1.3

Amends the Public Officer Prohibited Activities Act. Provides that an alderman of any city or a member of the board of trustees of any village or incorporated town (instead of a city, village, or incorporated town with fewer than 2,500 inhabitants) may also hold the office of member of the board of education, regional board of school trustees, board of school directors, or board of school inspectors. Effective immediately.

In a city, village, or incorporated town with fewer than 2,500 8 $inhabitants_r$ An alderman of <u>a</u> the city or a member of the board 9 of trustees of a village or incorporated town, during the term 10 11 of office for which he or she is elected, may also hold the office of member of the board of education, regional board of 12 school trustees, board of school directors, or board of school 13 14 inspectors.
