SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

20 ILCS 1305/1-35 new

Amends the Department of Human Services Act. Provides that the Department of Human Services must delay the request-for-proposals process for all services provided by the Department for FY05 until after the Department conducts a cost-benefit analysis. Provides that contracts with service providers that are in effect for FY04 shall remain in effect until the cost-benefit analysis is completed and the Department implements a new request-for-proposals process based on that analysis. Effective immediately.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Department of Human Services Act is amended
- 5 by adding Section 1-35 as follows:
- 6 (20 ILCS 1305/1-35 new)
- 7 Sec. 1-35. Requests for proposals; cost-benefit analysis.
- 8 The Department of Human Services shall delay the
- 9 request-for-proposals process for all services provided by the
- 10 Department for the State fiscal year beginning July 1, 2004
- 11 until after the Department conducts a cost-benefit analysis.
- 12 <u>Contracts with service providers that are in effect for the</u>
- 13 <u>State fiscal year ending June 30, 2004 shall remain in effect</u>
- 14 <u>until the cost-benefit analysis is completed and the Department</u>
- implements a new request-for-proposals process based on that
- 16 <u>analysis.</u>
- 17 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 18 becoming law.
