AN ACT making appropriations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

The following amounts, or so much thereof as 4 Section 5. may be necessary, are appropriated from the General Revenue 5 Fund to the Department of Human Services for FY05: 6 7 For the Family Assistance and Home Based Support 8 Services program\$10,000,000 9 For Centers for Independent Living for the expansion of services\$1,000,000 10 For increasing community living options 11 for the developmentally disabled that include, 12 but are not limited to, the expansion of Community 13 14 Integrated Living Arrangements, Supported Living, Shared Living Arrangements, and 15 Individual Family Options\$25,000,000 16 For a 4% Cost of Living increase for all 17 providers of the developmentally disabled 18 and the mentally ill.\$48,000,000 19 For the purposes of providing a rate increase 20 to Community Integrated Living Arrangements 21 for the developmentally disabled\$28,000,000 22 For the purposes of providing a rate increase 23 24 for transportation services for the 25 developmentally disabled\$13,600,000 For Community Integrated Living Arrangements 26 for the mentally ill and supportive housing 27 initiatives for the mentally ill\$11,700,000 28 29 For the expansion of respite services\$10,000,000 For Integrated Employment and Self-employment 30 Initiatives for the developmentally disabled 31 32 and the mentally ill\$10,000,000
