Amends the Illinois Public Aid Code. Makes technical changes in a Section regarding the extent of a responsible relative's liability for support.

1 AN ACT in relation to support.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Public Aid Code is amended by changing Section 10-2 as follows:
- 6 (305 ILCS 5/10-2) (from Ch. 23, par. 10-2)
- 7 Sec. 10-2. Extent of Liability. A husband is liable for
- 8 the support of his wife and a wife for the support of her
- 9 husband. Unless the child is otherwise emancipated, the parents
- are severally liable for the support of any child under age 18,
- and for any child aged 18 who is attending high school, until
- 12 that child graduates from high school, or attains the age of
- 13 19, whichever is earlier. The term "child" includes a child
- born out of wedlock, or legally adopted child.
- In addition to the primary obligation of support imposed
- 16 upon responsible relatives, the such relatives, if
- 17 individually or together in any combination they have
- 18 sufficient income or other resources to support a needy person,
- in whole or in part, shall be liable for any financial aid
- 20 extended under this Code to a person for whose support they are
- 21 responsible, including amounts expended for funeral and burial
- costs.
