## 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Criminal Code of 1961 is amended by changing
Section 12-5 as follows:

6 (720 ILCS 5/12-5) (from Ch. 38, par. 12-5)

7 Sec. 12-5. Reckless conduct.

8 (a) A person who causes bodily harm to or endangers the 9 bodily safety of an individual by any means, commits reckless 10 conduct if he <u>or she</u> performs recklessly the acts <u>that</u> <del>which</del> 11 cause the harm or endanger safety, whether they otherwise are 12 lawful or unlawful.

13 <u>(a-5) A person who causes great bodily harm or permanent</u> 14 <u>disability or disfigurement by any means, commits reckless</u> 15 <u>conduct if he or she performs recklessly the acts that cause</u> 16 <u>the harm, whether they otherwise are lawful or unlawful.</u>

17 (b) Sentence.

18Reckless conduct <u>under subsection (a)</u> is a Class A19misdemeanor. <u>Reckless conduct under subsection (a-5) is a Class</u>20<u>4 felony.</u>
