SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

625 ILCS 5/18b-101

from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 18b-101

Amends the Illinois Motor Carrier Safety Law in the Illinois Vehicle Code. Provides a vehicle that is used (as well as one that is designed) to transport more than 15 persons is a commercial vehicle. Provides that a vehicle used or designed to transport between 9 and 15 persons for direct compensation is a commercial vehicle, if the vehicle is being operated beyond a radius of 75 air miles from the driver's normal work reporting location. Effective immediately.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by changing
Section 18b-101 as follows:

Sec. 18b-101. Definitions. Unless the context otherwise
clearly requires, as used in this Chapter:

9 <u>"Air mile" means a nautical mile, which is equivalent to</u>
 10 <u>6,076 feet or 1,852 meters. Accordingly, 100 air miles are</u>
 11 <u>equivalent to 115.08 statute miles or 185.2 kilometers.</u>

"Commercial motor vehicle" means any self propelled or 12 towed vehicle used on public highways in interstate and 13 14 intrastate commerce to transport passengers or property when 15 the vehicle has a gross vehicle weight, a gross vehicle weight rating, a gross combination weight, or a gross combination 16 17 weight rating of 10,001 or more pounds; or the vehicle is used or designed to transport more than 15 passengers, including the 18 19 driver; or the vehicle is designed to carry 15 or fewer 20 passengers and is operated by a contract carrier transporting 21 employees in the course of their employment on a highway of this State; or the vehicle is used or designed to transport 22 between 9 and 15 passengers, including the driver, for direct 23 compensation, if the vehicle is being operated beyond a radius 24 of 75 air miles (86.3 statute miles or 138.9 kilometers) from 25 26 the driver's normal work reporting location; or the vehicle is used in the transportation of hazardous materials in a quantity 27 28 requiring placarding under the Illinois Hazardous Materials Transportation Act. This definition shall not include farm 29 30 machinery, fertilizer spreaders, and other special agricultural movement equipment described in Section 3-809 nor 31 32 implements of husbandry as defined in Section 1-130;

1 <u>"Direct compensation" means payment made to the motor</u> 2 <u>carrier by the passengers or a person acting on behalf of the</u> 3 <u>passengers for the transportation services provided, and not</u> 4 <u>included in a total package charge or other assessment for</u> 5 <u>highway transportation services;</u>

"Officer" means Illinois State Police Officer;

7 "Person" means any natural person or individual, 8 governmental body, firm, association, partnership, 9 copartnership, joint venture, company, corporation, joint 10 stock company, trust, estate or any other legal entity or their 11 legal representative, agent or assigns.
