

## 93RD GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2003 and 2004

## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

20 ILCS 2310/2310-610 new

Amends the Department of Public Health Powers and Duties Law of the Civil Administrative Code of Illinois. Provides that, subject to appropriation, the Department of Public Health shall establish and administer a program under which any individual who is not eligible to receive a free influenza vaccination through insurance, a health maintenance organization, or a similar plan shall, upon the individual's request, receive an influenza vaccination once each year to at no cost to the eligible individual. Provides that Department of Public Health shall adopt rules for the administration and operation of the program.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Department of Public Health Powers and
  Duties Law of the Civil Administrative Code of Illinois is
  amended by adding Section 2310-610 as follows:
- 7 (20 ILCS 2310/2310-610 new)
- 8 <u>Sec. 2310-610. Influenza vaccinations.</u>
- (a) As used in this Section, "eligible individual" means a 9 resident of Illinois who: (1) is not entitled to receive an 10 influenza vaccination at no cost as a benefit under a plan of 11 health insurance, a managed care plan, or a plan provided by a 12 health maintenance organization, a health services plan 13 corporation, or a similar entity; and (2) meets the 14 15 requirements established by the Department of Public Health by 16 rule.
- 17 <u>(b) Subject to appropriation, the Department of Public</u>
  18 <u>Health shall establish and administer a program under which any</u>
  19 <u>eligible individual shall, upon the eligible individual's</u>
  20 <u>request, receive an influenza vaccination once each year to at</u>
  21 no cost to the eligible individual.
- (c) The Department of Public Health shall adopt rules for 22 23 the administration and operation of the program, including but not limited to: determination of the influenza vaccine 24 formulation to be administered and the method of 25 26 administration; eligibility requirements and eligibility determinations; and standards and criteria for acquisition and 27 28 distribution of influenza vaccine and related supplies. The Department may enter into contracts or agreements with public 29 30 or private entities for the performance of such duties under the program as the Department may deem appropriate to carry out 31 this Section and its rules adopted under this Section. 32
