Amend House Bill 4992, AS AMENDED, by 3 replacing everything after the enacting clause with the 4 following: 5 "Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by adding 6 Sections 7-315.1 and 7-601.1 as follows: 7 (625 ILCS 5/7-315.1 new)Sec. 7-315.1. Proof of insurance; certain members of the 8 military serving outside of the United States. Any Illinois 9 resident serving in the military, who (i) is serving on active 10 duty outside of the United States and (ii) has met all 11 provisions for registration or driving privilege reinstatement 12 under this Chapter except filing proof of financial 13 responsibility, may have proof of financial responsibility 14 waived for reinstatement. Satisfactory proof that the person is 15 16 or will be serving in the military on active duty outside of the United States must be presented to the Secretary of State. 17 The Secretary shall adopt rules for implementing this Section. 18 (625 ILCS 5/7-601.1 new) 19 20 Sec. 7-601.1. Suspension of liability coverage; members of the military serving in active duty outside of the United 21 22 States.

(a) An insurer must suspend liability coverage on any motor

- vehicle owned or operated by a member of the United States 1
- Armed Forces, any Reserves component, or the National Guard, 2
- 3 serving on State or federal active duty outside of the United
- States. If all liability coverage of the vehicle is suspended, 4
- the vehicle must be inoperable or stored, as defined by rules 5
- adopted by the Secretary. 6
- 7 (b) Any resident of this State who (i) is a member of the
- United States Armed Forces, any Reserves component, or the 8
- National Guard, (ii) is or will be serving on active duty 9
- outside of the United States, and (iii) owns or drives a motor 10
- vehicle, must provide notice to his or her liability insurer 11
- requesting that the operator's liability coverage, or 12
- liability coverage of the person's vehicle or vehicles, be 13
- suspended while the person is serving on active duty outside of 14
- the United States. The person must include with the notice 15
- proof that he or she is or will be serving in the military on 16
- active duty outside of the United States. 17
- (c) Liability insurance coverage of the person's vehicle 18
- shall not resume until the person has notified the insurer of 19
- his or her return from active duty outside of the United 20
- 21 States.
- 22 (d) The Secretary shall adopt rules for implementing this
- Section.". 23
