Amends the State Commemorative Dates Act. Designates the first Sunday after Labor Day of each year as Great Grandparents Day.

1 AN ACT concerning State commemorative dates.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The State Commemorative Dates Act is amended by adding Section 31 as follows:
- 6 (5 ILCS 490/31 new)
- Sec. 31. Great Grandparents Day. The first Sunday after
 Labor Day of each year is designated as Great Grandparents Day
 to encourage the citizens of Illinois to honor and celebrate
- 10 great grandparents throughout the State.
