1 AN ACT in relation to criminal law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Criminal Code of 1961 is amended by changing
- 5 Section 16A-6 as follows:
- 6 (720 ILCS 5/16A-6) (from Ch. 38, par. 16A-6)
- 7 Sec. 16A-6. Affirmative defense. A detention as permitted
- 8 in this Article does not constitute an arrest or an unlawful
- 9 restraint, as defined in Section 10-3 of this Code, nor does
- 10 shall it render the merchant liable to the person so detained.
