Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Makes a technical change in a Section with regard to yielding the right of way.

1 AN ACT regarding vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by changing
- 5 Section 11-902 as follows:
- 6 (625 ILCS 5/11-902) (from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 11-902)
- 7 Sec. 11-902. Vehicle turning left.
- 8 The driver of a vehicle intending to turn to the left
- 9 within an intersection or into an alley, private road, or
- 10 driveway shall yield the right-of-way to any vehicle
- 11 approaching from the opposite direction which is so close as to
- 12 constitute an immediate hazard, but the said driver, having so
- 13 yielded may proceed at such time as a safe interval occurs.
