AN ACT concerning property.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Mobile Home Landlord and Tenant Rights Act 5 is amended by changing Section 1 as follows:

6 (765 ILCS 745/1) (from Ch. 80, par. 201)

Sec. 1. Applicability. This Act shall regulate and determine legal rights, remedies and obligations of the parties to any lease of a mobile home or mobile home lot in a mobile home park containing five or more mobile homes within this State. Any lease, written or oral, <u>is shall be</u> unenforceable insofar as any provision thereof conflicts with any provision of this Act.
