Amends the Health Care Surrogate Act. Makes a technical change in the Section concerning the preservation of existing rights.

1 AN ACT concerning health care.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Health Care Surrogate Act is amended by changing Section 55 as follows:
- 6 (755 ILCS 40/55) (from Ch. 110 1/2, par. 851-55)
- 7 Sec. 55. Preservation of existing rights. The provisions of this Act are cumulative with existing law regarding an 8 9 individual's right to consent or refuse to consent to medical treatment. The provisions of this Act shall not impair any 10 existing rights or responsibilities that a health care 11 12 provider, a patient, including a minor or a patient lacking decisional capacity, or a patient's family may have in regard 13 14 to the withholding or withdrawal of life-sustaining treatment, 15 including any rights to seek judicial review of decisions regarding life-sustaining treatment under the common law or 16 17 statutes of <u>Illinois</u> this State to the extent they are not inconsistent with the provisions of this Act. 18
