1 AN ACT in relation to the regulation of professions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Real Estate Appraiser Licensing Act of 2002
- 5 is amended by changing Section 1-5 as follows:
- 6 (225 ILCS 458/1-5)
- 7 (Section scheduled to be repealed on January 1, 2012)
- 8 Sec. 1-5. Legislative intent. The intent of the General
- 9 Assembly in enacting this Act is to evaluate the competency of
- 10 persons engaged in the appraisal of real estate in connection
- 11 with a federally related transaction and to license and
- 12 regulate those persons for the protection of the public.
- 13 Additionally, It is also the intent of the General Assembly for
- 14 this Act to be consistent with the provisions of Title XI of
- 15 the federal Financial Institutions Reform, Recovery and
- 16 Enforcement Act of 1989.
