## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Juvenile Court Act of 1987 is amended by changing Section 4-1 as follows:
- 6 (705 ILCS 405/4-1) (from Ch. 37, par. 804-1)
- 7 Sec. 4-1. Jurisdictional <u>Facts</u> facts. Proceedings may be
- 8 instituted under the provisions of this Article concerning boys
- 9 and girls who are addicted as defined in Section 4-3.
