SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Amends the Board of Higher Education Act, various Acts relating to the governance of public universities in Illinois, and the Public Community College Act. Requires public institutions of higher education to establish a policy regarding currently enrolled students who are called to or enlist in active military service. Requires the policy to provide that any student enrolled in a course or courses at the institution shall not incur academic or financial penalties by virtue of performing military service on behalf of the United States. Provides that the student must be permitted the option of either completing the course or courses at a later date without penalty or withdrawing from the course or courses to withdraw, the student's record shall reflect that the withdrawal is due to active military service. Effective July 1, 2004.

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AN ACT concerning higher education.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Board of Higher Education Act is amended by
adding Section 9.30 as follows:

6 (110 ILCS 205/9.30 new)

Sec. 9.30. Students called to active military service;
guidelines. The Board shall establish guidelines to assist
public institutions of higher education in establishing
policies regarding currently enrolled students who are called
to or enlist in active military service.

- Section 10. The University of Illinois Act is amended by adding Section 35 as follows:
- 14 (110 ILCS 305/35 new)

Sec. 35. Students called to active military service; 15 policy. The Board of Trustees shall establish, pursuant to 16 17 guidelines of the Board of Higher Education, a policy regarding currently enrolled students who are called to or enlist in 18 active military service. The policy shall provide that any 19 20 student enrolled in a course or courses at the university shall not incur academic or financial penalties by virtue of 21 performing military service on behalf of the United States. The 22 23 student must be permitted the option of either completing the 24 course or courses at a later date without penalty or withdrawing from the course or courses with a full refund of 25 fees paid. If the student chooses to withdraw, the student's 26 record shall reflect that the withdrawal is due to active 27 28 military service.

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Section 15. The Southern Illinois University Management

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1 Act is amended by adding Section 20 as follows:

3	Sec. 20. Students called to active military service;
4	policy. The Board shall establish, pursuant to guidelines of
5	the Board of Higher Education, a policy regarding currently
6	enrolled students who are called to or enlist in active
7	military service. The policy shall provide that any student
8	enrolled in a course or courses at the university shall not
9	incur academic or financial penalties by virtue of performing
10	military service on behalf of the United States. The student
11	must be permitted the option of either completing the course or
12	courses at a later date without penalty or withdrawing from the
13	course or courses with a full refund of fees paid. If the
14	student chooses to withdraw, the student's record shall reflect
15	that the withdrawal is due to active military service.

Section 20. The Chicago State University Law is amended by adding Section 5-130 as follows:

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(110 ILCS 660/5-130 new)

Sec. 5-130. Students called to active military service; 19 20 policy. The Board shall establish, pursuant to guidelines of the Board of Higher Education, a policy regarding currently 21 enrolled students who are called to or enlist in active 22 military service. The policy shall provide that any student 23 24 enrolled in a course or courses at the university shall not incur academic or financial penalties by virtue of performing 25 military service on behalf of the United States. The student 26 27 must be permitted the option of either completing the course or 28 courses at a later date without penalty or withdrawing from the course or courses with a full refund of fees paid. If the 29 student chooses to withdraw, the student's record shall reflect 30 that the withdrawal is due to active military service. 31

Section 25. The Eastern Illinois University Law is amended

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1 by adding Section 10-130 as follows:

3	Sec. 10-130. Students called to active military service;
4	policy. The Board shall establish, pursuant to guidelines of
5	the Board of Higher Education, a policy regarding currently
6	enrolled students who are called to or enlist in active
7	military service. The policy shall provide that any student
8	enrolled in a course or courses at the university shall not
9	incur academic or financial penalties by virtue of performing
10	military service on behalf of the United States. The student
11	must be permitted the option of either completing the course or
12	courses at a later date without penalty or withdrawing from the
13	course or courses with a full refund of fees paid. If the
14	student chooses to withdraw, the student's record shall reflect
15	that the withdrawal is due to active military service.

Section 30. The Governors State University Law is amended by adding Section 15-130 as follows:

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(110 ILCS 670/15-130 new)

Sec. 15-130. Students called to active military service; 19 20 policy. The Board shall establish, pursuant to guidelines of the Board of Higher Education, a policy regarding currently 21 enrolled students who are called to or enlist in active 22 military service. The policy shall provide that any student 23 24 enrolled in a course or courses at the university shall not incur academic or financial penalties by virtue of performing 25 military service on behalf of the United States. The student 26 27 must be permitted the option of either completing the course or 28 courses at a later date without penalty or withdrawing from the course or courses with a full refund of fees paid. If the 29 student chooses to withdraw, the student's record shall reflect 30 that the withdrawal is due to active military service. 31

Section 35. The Illinois State University Law is amended by

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1 adding Section 20-135 as follows:

3	Sec. 20-135. Students called to active military service;
4	policy. The Board shall establish, pursuant to guidelines of
5	the Board of Higher Education, a policy regarding currently
6	enrolled students who are called to or enlist in active
7	military service. The policy shall provide that any student
8	enrolled in a course or courses at the university shall not
9	incur academic or financial penalties by virtue of performing
10	military service on behalf of the United States. The student
11	must be permitted the option of either completing the course or
12	courses at a later date without penalty or withdrawing from the
13	course or courses with a full refund of fees paid. If the
14	student chooses to withdraw, the student's record shall reflect
15	that the withdrawal is due to active military service.

Section 40. The Northeastern Illinois University Law is amended by adding Section 25-130 as follows:

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(110 ILCS 680/25-130 new)

Sec. 25-130. Students called to active military service; 19 20 policy. The Board shall establish, pursuant to guidelines of the Board of Higher Education, a policy regarding currently 21 enrolled students who are called to or enlist in active 22 military service. The policy shall provide that any student 23 24 enrolled in a course or courses at the university shall not incur academic or financial penalties by virtue of performing 25 military service on behalf of the United States. The student 26 27 must be permitted the option of either completing the course or 28 courses at a later date without penalty or withdrawing from the course or courses with a full refund of fees paid. If the 29 student chooses to withdraw, the student's record shall reflect 30 that the withdrawal is due to active military service. 31

Section 45. The Northern Illinois University Law is amended

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1 by adding Section 30-140 as follows:

3	Sec. 30-140. Students called to active military service;
4	policy. The Board shall establish, pursuant to guidelines of
5	the Board of Higher Education, a policy regarding currently
6	enrolled students who are called to or enlist in active
7	military service. The policy shall provide that any student
8	enrolled in a course or courses at the university shall not
9	incur academic or financial penalties by virtue of performing
10	military service on behalf of the United States. The student
11	must be permitted the option of either completing the course or
12	courses at a later date without penalty or withdrawing from the
13	course or courses with a full refund of fees paid. If the
14	student chooses to withdraw, the student's record shall reflect
15	that the withdrawal is due to active military service.

Section 50. The Western Illinois University Law is amended by adding Section 35-135 as follows:

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(110 ILCS 690/35-135 new)

Sec. 35-135. Students called to active military service; 19 20 policy. The Board shall establish, pursuant to guidelines of the Board of Higher Education, a policy regarding currently 21 enrolled students who are called to or enlist in active 22 military service. The policy shall provide that any student 23 24 enrolled in a course or courses at the university shall not incur academic or financial penalties by virtue of performing 25 military service on behalf of the United States. The student 26 27 must be permitted the option of either completing the course or 28 courses at a later date without penalty or withdrawing from the course or courses with a full refund of fees paid. If the 29 student chooses to withdraw, the student's record shall reflect 30 that the withdrawal is due to active military service. 31

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changing Section 3-21 and by adding Section 3-26.5 as follows:

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(110 ILCS 805/3-21) (from Ch. 122, par. 103-21)

3 Sec. 3-21. The board of community college districts shall 4 have the duties enumerated in <u>the Sections following this</u> 5 <u>Section and preceding Section 3-30</u> Sections 3 22 through 6 3 29.2.

7 Notwithstanding any provision of this Article to the contrary, when bonds are issued by any district and the 8 purposes for which such bonds have been issued have been 9 10 accomplished and paid for in full and there remains funds on 11 hand in such bond and interest account, the board by resolution may transfer such excess to the fund of the district which 12 bears the nearest relation to the purpose for which the bonds 13 14 from which such excess funds arose were issued. 15 (Source: P.A. 86-1246.)

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(110 ILCS 805/3-26.5 new)

17 Sec. 3-26.5. Students called to active military service; 18 policy. The board shall establish, pursuant to guidelines of the Board of Higher Education, a policy regarding currently 19 enrolled students who are called to or enlist in active 20 21 military service. The policy shall provide that any student enrolled in a course or courses at the community college shall 22 not incur academic or financial penalties by virtue of 23 performing military service on behalf of the United States. The 24 25 student must be permitted the option of either completing the course or courses at a later date without penalty or 26 withdrawing from the course or courses with a full refund of 27 28 fees paid. If the student chooses to withdraw, the student's 29 record shall reflect that the withdrawal is due to active military service. 30

31 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect on July 32 1, 2004.
