SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

720 ILCS 5/16D-5.1 new

Amends the Criminal Code of 1961. Creates the offense of facilitating theft of on-line services. Penalty is a Class A misdemeanor when the aggregate value of service obtained is less than \$300 and a Class 4 felony when the aggregate value of service obtained is \$300 or more. A second or subsequent offense is a Class 2 felony.

1 AN ACT concerning criminal law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Criminal Code of 1961 is amended by adding Section 16D-5.1 as follows:
- 6 (720 ILCS 5/16D-5.1 new)
- 7 Sec. 16D-5.1. Facilitating theft of on-line services.
- 8 (a) A person commits the offense of facilitating theft of 9 on-line services who knowingly:
 - (1) makes, obtains, possesses, or uses a computer or other electronic device, or computer software with the capability to gain unauthorized access to a commercial or non-commercial on-line service or computerized web intended to gather and disseminate information by electronic means, and uses the electronic machinery or computer software in his or her possession or use to gain unauthorized access to an on-line service or information web; or
 - (2) sells, distributes, gives, or otherwise transfers to another, or offers, promotes, or advertises a computer or electronic device or computer software with the capability to gain unauthorized access to a commercial or non-commercial on-line service or computerized web intended to gather and disseminate information by electronic means, under circumstances evidencing an intent to use or employ these items, or to allow them to be used or employed, for the purpose of gaining unauthorized access to a commercial or non-commercial on-line service or computerized web intended to gather and disseminate information by electronic means.
- 31 (b) Sentence. Facilitating theft of on-line services is a 32 Class A misdemeanor when the aggregate value of service

- 4 <u>offense has been previously convicted of any similar crime in</u>
