Amends the Code of Civil Procedure. Makes a technical change in the Section concerning punitive damages in healing art and legal malpractice cases.

1 AN ACT concerning civil procedure.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Code of Civil Procedure is amended by changing Section 2-1115 as follows:
- 6 (735 ILCS 5/2-1115) (from Ch. 110, par. 2-1115)
- 7 Sec. 2-1115. Punitive damages not recoverable in healing
- 8 art and legal malpractice cases. In <u>any case</u> all cases, whether
- 9 in tort, contract or otherwise, in which the plaintiff seeks
- damages by reason of legal, medical, hospital, or other healing
- 11 art malpractice, no punitive, exemplary, vindictive or
- 12 aggravated damages shall be allowed.
