Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

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ARTICLE 1

Section 1. 28 Section 2. The sum of \$375,000, or so much thereof as 29 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention 30 Fund to the Office of the State Fire Marshal for HB7216 -2- OMB093 00253 SNP 40047 b administrative expenses of the Elevator Safety and Regulation Act.

Section 3. The sum of \$50,000, or so much thereof as may 3 be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Firefighters' 4 Memorial Fund to the Office of the State Fire Marshal for 5 expenses related to the maintenance of the Illinois 6 Firefighters' Memorial, holding the annual Fallen Firefighter 7 Ceremony, and other expenses as allowed under Public Act 91-8 0832. 9
