1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 1. The following named amounts, or so much
6 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects
7 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated from the
8 Industrial Commission Operations Fund to the Industrial
9 Commission:

13 Section 2. In addition to the amounts heretofore
14 appropriated, the following named amount, or so much thereof
15 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Industrial
16 Commission Operations Fund to the Industrial Commission for
17 the project hereinafter enumerated:

21 Section 3. The amount of \$119,800, or so much thereof as
22 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Industrial
23 Commission Operations Fund to the Industrial Commission for
24 printing and distribution of Workers' Compensation handbooks
25 containing information as to the rights and obligations of
26 employers.

27 Section 4. The amount of \$279,300, or so much thereof as
28 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Industrial
29 Commission Operations Fund to the Industrial Commission for
30 the implementation and operation of an accident reporting
31 system.

1 Section 5. The sum of \$120,600, or so much thereof as
2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Industrial
3 Commission Operations Fund to the Industrial Commission for
4 all costs associated with the establishment and operation of
5 a satellite office in the Metro East area.

6 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect on July 1,
7 2004.
