Section 35. The sum of \$13,200,000, or so much thereof 14 as may be necessary is appropriated to the Department of 15 State Police from the Federal Civil 16 Preparedness 17 Administrative Fund for Terrorism Task Force Approved Purchases for Homeland Security. 18

19 Section 40. The following amounts, or so much thereof as 20 may be necessary for the objects and purposes hereinafter 21 named, are appropriated from the General Revenue Fund and the 22 Drug Traffic Prevention Fund to the Department of State 23 Police, Division of Operations, pursuant to the provisions of 24 the "Intergovernmental Drug Laws Enforcement Act" for Grants 25 to Metropolitan Enforcement Groups.

30 Section 45. In the event of the receipt of funds from 31 the Motor Vehicle Theft Prevention Council, through a grant 1 from the Criminal Justice Information Authority, the amount 2 of \$1,200,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is 3 appropriated from the State Police Motor Vehicle Theft 4 Prevention Trust Fund to the Department of State Police for 5 payment of expenses.

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6 Section 50. The sum of \$1,500,000 or so much thereof as 7 may be necessary, is appropriated from the State Police 8 Whistleblower Reward and Prevention Fund to the Department of 9 State Police for payment of their expenditures for state law 10 enforcement purposes in accordance with the State 11 Whistleblower Protection Act.

Section 55. The following amounts, or so much thereof as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Department of State Police for expenses of Racetrack Investigative Services under the "Illinois Horse Racing Act of 1975":
