HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION 1 WHEREAS, Identity theft is a major and growing problem in 2 3 the United States and in Illinois; and WHEREAS, An individual's social security number is a 4 primary means of identifying the individual, and the 5 unauthorized disclosure of the individual's social security 7 number creates a substantial risk that the individual's 8 identity may be stolen; and 9 WHEREAS, Certain State officers and agencies require individuals to disclose their social security numbers for 10 various reasons, thus creating the potential for the theft of 11 those individuals' identities if their social security numbers 12 13 are further disclosed without authorization; and WHEREAS, The State should take all necessary steps to 14 15 ensure that the procedures used by its officers and agencies do 16 not facilitate the theft of individuals' identities through the unauthorized disclosure of those individuals' social security 17 numbers; therefore, be it 18 19 THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES RESOLVED, ΒY $\cap F$ THE NINETY-THIRD GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, THE 20 SENATE CONCURRING HEREIN, that the Social Security Number 21 22 Protection Task Force is created; and be it further 23 RESOLVED, That the task force shall consist of the 24 following members: 25 (1)One member representing the House of 26 Representatives, appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives; 27 28 (2) member representing One the House of Representatives, appointed by the Minority Leader of the 29

- (4) One member representing the Senate, appointed by the Minority Leader of the Senate;
- (5) One member representing the Office of the Attorney General, appointed by the Attorney General;
- (6) One member representing the Office of the Secretary of State, appointed by the Secretary of State;
- (7) One member representing the Office of the Governor, appointed by the Governor;
- (8) One member representing the Department of Natural Resources, appointed by the Director of Natural Resources;
- (9) One member representing the Department of Public Aid, appointed by the Director of Public Aid;
- (10) One member representing the Department of Revenue, appointed by the Director of Revenue; and
- (11) One member representing the Department of State Police, appointed by the Director of State Police; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the task force shall examine the procedures used by the State to protect an individual against the unauthorized disclosure of his or her social security number when the State requires the individual to provide his or her social security number to an officer or agency of the State; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the task force shall report its findings and recommendations to the Governor, the Attorney General, the Secretary of State, and the General Assembly no later than the first day of the 2004 fall veto session of the 93rd General Assembly.
