- 8 WHEREAS, Registered nurses provide the necessary
- 9 treatment, continual assessment of conditions, and education
- that patients require when hospitalized; and

- 12 American Medical Association and the New England Journal of
- 13 Medicine found a direct link between higher number of nurses
- 14 assigned to patients and lower adverse patient outcomes; and

- 16 together to call for quality health care measures including
- 17 safe staffing, reporting of employee turnover and hours
- 18 worked, and public disclosure of hospital infection and
- 19 mortality rates; therefore, be it

- 22 we do hereby recognize Tuesday, May 6, 2003, as National
