

1 HOUSE RESOLUTION

3 11, 2001, the 933rd Military Police Company (Combat Support)

22 NINETY-THIRD GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that  
23 we honor the brave and selfless men and women of all  
24 components of the United States and allied armed forces for  
25 their great personal sacrifice, and especially the 933rd  
26 Military Police Company (Combat Support) for their dedication  
27 to our State and country, for their defense of our freedom  
28 and security, and for their willingness to answer the call to  
29 duty during this time of danger to our country; and be it

1 on active service from Illinois, as they undertake their
