WHEREAS, The continued operation of Vandalia Correctional 2 3 Center is vital to the economy and public safety of the State 4 of Illinois; and WHEREAS, Vandalia Correctional Center employs or has 5 contracts with over 500 persons and is the largest employer in Fayette County; and 7 8 WHEREAS, The closing of Vandalia Correctional Center will devastate the economy of Fayette County; and 9 10 WHEREAS, Governor Rod Blagojevich has not included funding of Vandalia Correctional Center in his fiscal year 2005 budget 11 12 and planned on closing the facility on July 1, 2004; and WHEREAS, Upon hearing of the Governor's proposal to close 13 14 the facility, Vandalia Mayor Rick Gottman organized a petition 15 drive to keep the facility open and has rallied his community in support of this effort; and 16 17 WHEREAS, The fiscal year 2005 Illinois State budget will continue to fund Vandalia Correctional Center; and 18 19 WHEREAS, Without Mayor Gottman's outstanding leadership, 20 hard work, and dedication to his community, Vandalia 21 Correctional Center would not be funded; therefore, be it 22 RESOLVED, ΒY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF NINETY-THIRD GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we 23 24 congratulate Vandalia Mayor Rick Gottman on his outstanding leadership, hard work, and dedication to his community in 2.5 26 keeping Vandalia Correctional Center open; and be it further
